lumbung Kios is a network of decentralized and self-run kios at different locations by the lumbung members, lumbung artists, and their local ekosistem. It's also an attempt to decentralize distribution mechanisms and to explore alternative and sustainable economies. The aim is to keep the environmental impact as low as possible. For this reason, lumbung Kios partly tries to experiment with the Feral Trade (a mechanism that was established by artist Kate Rich) to trade goods using the active-physical mobility resources of lumbung Kios' existing social network. There will be diverse physical lumbung Kios during documenta fifteen: at ruruHaus in cooperation with Walter König Bookstore, at Hübner area and at the spaces of the network of Kios' local shop partners that are spread through the city of Kassel.

lumbung Kios works in collaboration with: Colorlabor, kmmn_practice, Galerie auf Zeit (GaZ), Wildwood Gallery and Store, ZweiPunktNull, Stadtliebe, Lost & Found Record Store, Rotopol, Sandershaus and WIKULLiL at Lemon House. The wish is to be able to work with a few more. currently, there are still some conversations going on with several other local shop partners in Kassel.



The Ecology of Desertification and Black Soil Beach is an ongoing creative research and practice and based on 28 Thangka paintings about the ecological story of the grassland created by local environmentalist Mr. Barang. It reveals a touching story of the herdsmen living in the fragile ecosystem and trying to rebuild the spiritual connection with the enviroment.

A fine yak is valued highly in a nomadic way of life because it has many benefits, from being a cattle to becoming an ecological craft product. In 2019, the first batch of ecological craft production began. By combining art and traditional handmade, their modern workshops have successfully produced felt slippers, not only to supplement farmers income but also as an innovative way to respond to ecological issues.



Among the things haenyeo (women divers who harvests sea life from the ocean without oxygen supply and mostly based in Jeju Island) harvests, the most physically difficult to harvest is Umi or Agar (red algae), even though they had been doing it for a long time. This handkerchief is prepared as a gift for haenyeo to wipe off their sweat.

Sa Sa Art Projects

Sa Sa Art Projects is an artist-run initiative dedicated to experimental and critical contemporary art practices. It was founded in 2010 by the arts collective Stiev Selapak and operated from a historic and vibrant apartment complex known as the White Building in Phnom Penh until 2017, when the building was demolished for new development.

Hand painted with acrylic paints for fabric



Using a combination of canvas and rubber material, these shoes are suitable for daily wear. The artists have also carefully hand painted the shoes using acrylic paints for fabric to make it vibrant. Sometimes, depending on the artist, they will use different techniques and designs. The irregularity of the brushstrokes shown by the artists make the shoes more special.

LIM SOKCHANLINA:

NATIONAL ROAD NUMBER 5 (2015)



National Road Number 5 stretches across 407 kilometers which connect Cambodia's capital Phnom Peng with the border of Thailand. Along that road as well, a number of residential houses were impacted (their frontages sliced open) by the Japanese and China government-funded expansion of the highway to serve a purpose of transforming existing land to roadside industrial zones while facilitating the transportation of goods between Bangkok and Ho Chi Minh City.

THOAMADA (2011) Postcard, A5





Thoamada is a Khmer expression which means things are natural, habitual, okay, or the usual. The series portrays personal stories of nine Khmer men who have sex with men which collected during an intense workshop. The aim is to build intimate public dialogue about and among the LGBT communities. Each participant was asked to make a facepaint to express their identity. The results are very personal and meaningful. One participant painted his face as a cat, which captured his affinity towards the feline and his cat-like personality. Everyone was free to be the creators of their own stories.

Wajukuu Art Project

Wajukuu Art Project is a community-based organization established in 2004 by a group of artists in the Lunga-Lunga neighborhood of the Mukuru slum in Nairobi. The common goal is to make Mukuru a place where children can thrive and to create employment through the production and sale of quality artworks. Art forms the backbone of Wajukuu, not just as a practice but a way of life. Through art classes, Wajukuu empowers children and youth to cope with daily challenges, and speak out against injustices imposed on them.

This trilogy is a collaborative work of MAMA artists and contributors during the 5 years program Nuevatopias (2010–2016).


Más Arte Más Acción (MAMA)

This photo-novel transports you to the age of the Cold War in the Eastern Mediterranean and North Africa and the hidden practices of publishing culture. Readers will follow the story of three women Afaf Samra, Hala Haddad, and Huda Al Wadi whose respective fates brought them together. A chain of events unfolds and brings them together in a thrilling journey full of contradictions and inner struggles in a cultural environment dominated by patriarchy, and the powers of money and politics.

Bark beetles (Scolytinae) are named after their habit of feeding the inner layer of tree (phloem). This bug species is also known to leave significant trails carved into the tree's phloem by female beetles and their larvae. This t-shirt is using those beautiful and enigmatic trails as a way to evoke the relationships between the grassroots organisations, artists, and cultural initiatives which MAMA has developed an ecosystem for. In this ecosystem, different ways of life, artistic practices, and relationships within the territory are entangled.

In 2015, the private library of Abd Al-Rahman Munif, Arabic author and novelist, was burglarized in his residence in Damascus. Using personal and research approaches, When the *Library Was Stolen* interweaves the process of documentation and proposes a re-reading of the Arab private library archive from many perspectives. The book is based on a long-term research by Fehras Publishing Practices followed by cataloging its content that counts approximately 10,000 publications.

AN EXPANDED FIELD GUIDE BY ALISON TURNBULL Book, 17.2 x 24 cm



Psyche is the ancient Greek word for both butterfly and soul. PSYCHE. Or, the butterfly – An Expanded Field Guide is Alison Turnbull's observational record, both literal and imaginary, of the expedition. This book of butterflies is a natural history field guide comprising drawings, photographs, notes, fragments, and literary sources. It also includes The Mimic Net, a new essay by writer and mythographer Marina Warner and an illustrated fold-out poster guide to the butterflies of the region by Dr. Huertas.

Fehras Publishing Practices is an artist collective founded in Berlin in 2015 by Sami Rustom, Omar Nicolas, and Kenan Darwich. 


